

What can I bring?

You can bring just about anything: computer, GPS, compass, map (city and transit), money, public transit day pass, but nothing that will give you a transportation edge, like rollerblades or a skateboard etc.

How long does it take?

Once Upon A Race takes around between 3 and 4 hours. Race will end the race at the 4 hour mark, which is 3pm. At that time if you haven't completed the race, head back over to Stoney's Bar & Grill.

Why can't I take a taxi or wear rollerblades, ride a skateboard etc?

We want all of our participants to be on the same playing field, thus no bikes, cabs, rollerblades, sneakers with wheels on them, and so on. Beware, we have spies posted throughout the course.

Will maps be provided?

No. It is up to each team to provide their own city or public transportation maps. All Check Points will be within a 5 mile radius of the starting point.

What if I can't figure out a clue?

You can ask people on the street for help. Call your friends or family for advice. Use the Internet. Just don't give up.

How many people on a team?

You may have 2 to 6 people on a team. All members must pay registration. All teams are eligible to win all prizes.

Can my team split up to do challenges?

No! You must complete each challenge as a team.

Besides walking, does this require intense physical activity like climbing walls or anything?

No. Once Upon A Race is not a test of strength, but rather, a test of wits and fun challenges.

What is first prize?

\$300! To the winning team!

Are there prizes for second place?

Yes. Second Place Team will walk away with \$150. Great prizes are awarded for Best Costume Team, and Individual

Are there prizes for third place?

Yes. Third Place Team will walk away with \$75.

Yes! There are Prizes for the Best Costume! Best Team Costume and Best Individual Costume!**How do we prove we completed each challenge/checkpoint?**

Your designated team captain will take a piece of swag/gear from each finished challenge. They should be decked out in 10 different pieces of swag/gear at the end of the race.

When will we receive our clues?

Your first clue will be given to you the morning of the race as soon as your team arrives. Each subsequent clue will be given to you at your next checkpoint once you have complete the checkpoint challenge.
